How can a cultural welfare programme be evaluated? With what methodologies, tools and alliances?

The Take Part project, promoted by Sistema MTA, has sought to provide some answers to these questions. These answers are neither definitive nor exhaustive, but they can guide choices, generate results and offer a starting point for new shared projects. Take Part, dedicated to assessing the social impact of museum programmes aimed at people with dementia, represented an important opportunity for professional growth for all those who participated.

Today, we wish to share this experience with the informal network of Italian Museums for Dementia: to recount reflections, lessons learned and perspectives that emerged from the process, and to explore together what it really means to evaluate a cultural welfare programme. We will do this through interactive workshops, to co-design common tools and give rise to future shared research.
